Borough finances were reported to have \$1,350,956.77 in the general fund and a total cash position of \$1,822,981.86

3. Resolution to authorize the publication of delinquent tax payers

**COUNCIL DISCUSSION –**

Council discussed potential options for the use of the federal American Recovery Plan Act including green infrastructure to reduce CSS overflows, potentially partnering with Wilkesburg-Penn Joint Water Authority and others to replace lead service lines and assisting RIDC Keystone Commons with flooding issues from the Turtle Creek.

Mr. Reyes provided an update of topics and sessions at the Allegheny League of Municipalities conference at Seven Springs from 6/18/6/20.

Mayor Adams spoke about the Borough's efforts to rebrand - to show people that East Pittsburgh is a quiet and safe place to live and that the public perception of crime is unwarranted.

Mr. Frazier provided an update on the basketball clinic.
